Global Fire Ministries is an international ministry focused on the end-time harvest and exists to resurrect, revive, restore, and reveal the glory of God in genuine biblical Christianity as demonstrated in the gospels of Jesus Christ. Founder Jeff Jansen and his team carry the saving, healing, and delivering power of Jesus Christ throughout the world, spreading the fires of revival and equipping groups to operate in hands-on power evangelism and the supernatural while on the mission field. Our mission is to teach, train, and equip the believing body of Christ how to live and move in the supernatural by emphasizing communion and intimacy with the Holy Spirit as completely essential for transformation. Global Fire Ministries conducts healing evangelism outreaches, glory explosion meetings, crusades, and campaigns throughout the nations of the world, bringing countless souls into the saving knowledge of Christ Jesus.

We believe that we are to carry the Kingdom of God as ambassador representatives everywhere we go. Jesus displayed this as the first of a new breed of man, a Spirit filled man, and role-modeled what we were to do as Spirit-filled sons and daughters of the Kingdom. The desire of God is to have a people who will rightly display His glory and the power of the Kingdom throughout the nations—our desire is the same.

Part of the mandate for Global Fire Ministries is to impart and multiply the tangible healing anointing and to equip believers to operate in miracles, signs, and wonders all while preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom. Our foreign missions trips enable pastors, lay leaders, and *all believers* to receive impartation, training, and to get firsthand experience in the nations. For those who hunger to see the greater works Jesus spoke of in John 14:12, our mission trips provide a platform to see the lost saved, the deaf hear, the blind see, the paralytic walk, and the demonic set free.

What you will do on a Global Fire Mission Trip...

Our ministry teams meet nightly on our large evangelism campaigns, conferences, and glory explosion gatherings to pray for hundreds, if not thousands of people to be saved, healed, and delivered. In addition, there are many impartation and training and equipping sessions, times of soaking prayer and personal ministry from Jeff, and Global Fire Ministries' staff and associates.

In addition to the larger crusades, gatherings, and campaigns we host, there are often many other ministry opportunities. You will have the chance to participate in spontaneous marketplace ministry and may visit hospitals, prisons, orphanages, schools, etc. There are sometimes conferences scheduled for local pastors and leaders in the nation we are visiting. We also set aside at least one day for rest, sightseeing, and shopping for the team.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

You will see in this application that we require considerable, in-depth information from *all* applicants, prior to their approval, due to the extent of this type of ministry. Quite often, the first time team members meet one another is at the airport in route to the mission field and even sometimes not until our first training and equipping session in the mission field. Therefore it's imperative that we garner as much background information as possible to assist us. Although you will be submitting personal information to us, please know that it is kept confidential between GFM mission coordinators and team leaders.

TEAMS

On larger mission trips, each person in the group will be assigned to smaller teams with a team leader. Such teams may be formed from specific church groups, or they may be a mixture of different people from various churches and denominations.

MINISTRY CONDITIONS

Many of the places we visit and the local hotel conditions therein are often below the standards you would expect to see in the Western world. The pace of these trips can be rigorous, emotionally challenging, and physically draining. Team members must often stand through long days and continue functioning in what can often be difficult circumstances. We ask that you be prepared and willing to endure some discomfort, while simultaneously enjoying the immeasurable reward that comes with the outpouring of God's Spirit!

Most importantly, stay flexible! Plans can often change at a moment's notice. Exhaustion may try to set in, so please come with an attitude of servanthood. We want to model the servant nature of Christ to those we reach and pray for, as well as our fellow team members, drivers, guides and everyone around us.

OPENNESS TO HOLY SPIRIT

Global Fire Ministries welcomes team members from all church backgrounds, denominations, and ministry streams. However, it is imperative that the team be aware of the ministry style and DNA of Global Fire Ministries. We are extremely tolerant and supportive of physical manifestations; Holy Spirit "drunkenness," joy and laughter; shaking and strange noises; and many other ecstatic demonstrations that often occur when the Spirit of God touches His people. Such manifestations are common ways the Lord chooses to operate through us in the glory realm. IN NO WAY do we force or place expectancy on team members to respond to the Spirit in such a manner. However, we *WILL NOT* tolerate criticism, stifling, or resistance toward those who are experiencing God in such a fashion. Believe us when we say that mission trips have nearly crashed when team members took offense at this type of activity. If you are uncomfortable seeing manifestations in a church setting, you will not enjoy an entire week of it on the mission field. Please come with an expectancy and a willingness to enjoy the Lord with this in mind.

COST

The cost of a trip is dependent on several factors and varies from one trip to another. Typical overseas trips cost somewhere in the range of \$3,500 USD. These costs include airfare from a U.S. hub (you will be responsible for reaching the departure hub on your own), two meals a day, hotel accommodations, ground transportation, travel medical insurance, airport taxes, day trip and administrative fees. The cost for trips will obviously be less if you are traveling to the mission field on your own and choose to purchase your entire airfare.

Receipt of your deposit tentatively holds your spot pending review and approval of your application. Space is limited and acceptance is based on first come, first serve basis. If no deposit is received with your application, we regret that we will not be able to process your application. Deposits are required to forward fund costs associated with the trip (i.e. hotel, transportation, etc.). Make checks and money orders payable to "Global Fire Ministries." All amounts must be in U.S. dollars.

You will receive a *confirmation e-mail* when your application has been received to verify whether we have a completed application package. Upon the approval of your application, you will also receive an *acceptance e-mail* for joining the team. Upon closing of the registration period, an *informational e-mail* containing details of the trip will be emailed to you as well.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

If your brother wrongs you, go and show him his fault, between you and him privately. If he listens to you, you have won back your brother. But if he does not listen, take along with you one or two others, so that every word may be confirmed and upheld by the testimony of two or three witnesses. If he pays no attention to them [refusing to listen and obey], tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a pagan and a tax collector (Matt. 18:15-17, AMP).

Our aim is to follow biblical standards of discipline within the context of our ministry trips.

The goal of this policy is to clarify disciplinary procedures in order to avoid misunderstanding and provide clear guidelines for the safety and effectiveness of the team. We ask that you read the following procedures, sign the consent form and return it to us. In doing this, you agree to compliance with the decisions made by leadership; you agree to receive correction, public rebuke and/or removal as outlined in the procedures. If issues of sin or noncompliance with leadership surface, know with certainty that we will follow the steps below to bring resolution to the situation.

The reason for this policy is simple. The aim of these trips is to open regions up to revival and renewal, and in doing so, they become targets for spiritual warfare. We recognize that if you are not walking right with God, the accuser can find an open door and use it against you. If the opening is small, then a small correction will bring resolve to the situation. If the sin has taken root for too long, even loving correction from friends may not turn you aside. If this should happen, you will be asked to leave and if you choose not to leave, we will bring you before the ministry team and inform them that they must have nothing to do with you. In signing this consent policy, you agree to abide by the decisions of Global Fire Ministries' missions leadership and their collective wisdom in handling such matters.

We understand that it is difficult if not inappropriate for everyone to know the specifics of every possible scenario on the mission field, and that you must trust those in authority to seek the Lord in their decisions. By signing this policy, you agree to abide by their decisions totally. Please understand that we want only to work alongside each of you, yet we must also be realistic in laying out basic guidelines, so that the ministry trip is not ruined because of one person's sin or noncompliance. Because of our experience with similar situations, we will endeavor to bring cohesion to the team to prevent chaos. We ask that you approach the mission field with a war mindset, not letting down your guard, and know that compliance with the decisions of leadership are not optional but mandatory.

1. If you have a problem with anyone on the team, you should go to that person without approaching anyone else first. Try to bring resolution and understanding to the situation. If it is someone of the opposite sex, speak with them in a place where others are around but unable to hear. Very often, a perceived problem is only a misunderstanding that can be cleared up with communication and bringing it to someone's attention.
2. If you cannot reach resolution after talking with the other person, bring the issue to your team leader. The individuals involved are required to discuss the problem with the team leader, and the leader will determine whether someone is at fault and bring closure to the situation.
3. If the team leader later finds that no closure has come following the meeting, he will confront the parties with the event coordinator. The team leader will inform him of the situation, to bring in another voice of reason and authority and arrive at closure.
4. If the team leader and event coordinator have found the person to be in rebellion to correction, then they will inform the senior Global Fire Ministries' representative and he will bring final closure to the situation. All parties will be present and they will hear how the matter will be ended. At this time, options will be given for ending the situation, and it will end. Options may include returning home within 24 hours or be brought before the entire mission team. If the second option is chosen, the team will be instructed not to have anything to do with you for the rest of the trip. You will not be allowed to ride, sleep, eat or spend time with any team member.

5. If you are involved in a sin that cannot be addressed in a timely manner—and which could adversely affect the team—the leadership reserves the right to go immediately to step 4 at their discretion.
6. In signing this agreement, you agree to follow these procedures for discipline if you are directly involved. You also agree to follow the directions of leadership regarding other team members.

After your application has been accepted, you may cancel up to 30 days prior to the departure date in order to receive a \$350 refund of this deposit. Any other trip balance payments will be refunded fully if you cancel up to 30 days prior to the departure date.

If for any reason, a team member cancels *after the cutoff date* (30 days prior to the departure date), the deposit and any trip balance payments will be *forfeited*.
